### Fifth Sunday in Lent

#### Gospel: John 11:1-45

This Sunday we hear about an amazing thing that Jesus does when his friend Lazarus becomes sick and dies. Let's think a bit more about this today.

Jesus hears that his friend Lazarus who lives in Bethany is sick. By the time Jesus gets there Lazarus is dead and has been buried for four days.

Jesus goes to the tomb and asks them to roll away the stone which was blocking the entrance. He tells Lazarus to come out of the tomb. Lazarus walks out, covered in the cloths that he was buried in.

How do you think Mary, Martha and the other people there feel when they see Lazarus walking out of the tomb?

Why do you think Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead? (So that the people believe that Jesus is the Son of God.)

Jesus came to bring new life to all people – to show us how to live so that when we die we can have a new life in heaven.

God gives life to us all. God created us and wants every single one of us to live a happy life, with all the things that we need to grow and be the best people we can be.

Is this what always happens?

Not everyone in the world has all the things that they need. Some of our families don't have jobs and so don't have money for things like food and clothes. Some of us don't have clean running water. Some of us don't have anywhere safe to live. Some of us don't have the chance to go to school.

Do you think it is right that some of us do not have all the things that we need to live, while some of us have more than enough?

God created the world for all of us, with food and water to share, but not everyone is getting their fair share. Some of us have too much. And some of us don't have enough.

But we can help to make a new life for ourselves and for others around the world. A world where everyone does have the chance to be happy.

A world where everyone has the things that they need.

How do you think we can do this?

Jesus came to show us how to live, how to treat others. This Lent we can look at our own lives, and think about the changes that we can make so that everyone can live their lives to the full. It might be hard, but we can make a big difference to communities around the world.
