### This Sunday's reading – fifth Sunday of Easter

John 14: 1-12

In the Gospel reading Jesus tells us that through him we will come to know God and that we should trust in him as we trust in God.

The reading is a little bit complicated. Jesus is telling his disciples that he is the Son of God. But the disciples find it difficult to understand.

Right at the beginning of the gospel, Jesus tells the disciples not to be worried and to trust in him. What does it mean to trust someone?

Trusting someone means believing that they are always there for us, that they are always willing to help us, that they will keep our secrets and comfort us when we are upset or frightened.

We all have people in our lives that we trust. Who do you trust? How does it feel when someone breaks your trust?

Do other people trust you? How can we help other people to trust in us?

We can also trust in God. We know that God is always there for us and wants what's best for us. God is always ready to listen.

How can we share our worries with God? How can we show our trust in God? We can talk to God through prayer. When we pray we can share all our worries and fears and also all our joys and hopes with God. And we can show our trust in God by listening to what Jesus asks of us and by trying to follow him. By loving one another and by doing what is right, we are doing what God wants us to do.
