Focus: Phase 1 Phonics

Following Letters and Sounds we will be covering rhythm and rhyme, alliteration, oral blending and segmenting. When reading stories point out any words that sound the same.

**We will be learning to read our name.**

## Topic

Focus: Celebrations

We will be learning all about Guy Fawkes and why we celebrate Bonfire Night. We will then look at different celebrations we have with our families – if you have a celebration coming up please share it with the Nursery staff.

## Maths

Focus: Counting and number recognition

We will continue to focus on careful counting of objects in different arrangements and numeral recognition.

Encourage your child to count different objects at home.

## RE

Theme: Welcome and Birthday

We will be learning about Baptism and what it means to be baptised. We have organised a trip to our school church so we can see first-hand how we are welcomed into God's family.

Through studying the Christmas story and practising our Nativity play, we will learn that Christmas is the celebration of the birth of Jesus.
