This Sunday's reading – First Sunday of Advent

Gospel: Mark 13:33-37

The gospel story is telling us that we must be ready when Jesus comes again, but that we cannot be exactly sure when that will be, so we must try to be ready all the time. (Although we don't have to stay awake all night, we can go to sleep!)

Jesus asks us to look out and keep our eyes open for what is happening around us, so that we are ready when he comes.

What do you think Jesus wants us to see when we look around us?

Do we sometimes see people who need our help? People who are lonely? People who are sad? People who do not feel well?

What do you think Jesus would like us to do when we see people who are sad, lonely, poor or sick?

Sometimes we hear the story of people who live a long way away but who also need our help.

Today is the First Sunday of Advent. When we begin Advent it is the beginning of a journey. Some journeys are more welcome than others. Some people are forced into making journeys that are long and dangerous as they are trying to find a place of safety.

There are many children who are refugees. They and their families find themselves without anything at all. They rely on volunteers to watch out for them and provide everything they need. They are often sad and frightened by their situation.

It is sad to think that children are in situations where they feel unsafe or far from home.

Why do you think it is important to know about the lives of people who are living in other parts of the world?

How do you think you could help someone who was in this situation?

What will you do next time you see or hear about someone who needs your help?

How will you make sure you are ready for Jesus when he comes again?
