This Sunday's reading – Second Sunday of Advent

Gospel: Mark 1:1-8

Today we hear about John the Baptist and how he was a messenger for God, preparing people for the coming of Jesus. What do you remember about John in this reading? What does he wear? What does he eat? What does he do in the river?

How do we prepare during Advent?

We put up a Christmas tree and decorate it. We buy presents for other people and we wrap them up.

When John the Baptist began to prepare the way for Jesus, it wasn't just for his friends and family. His message was for everyone who would listen.

When we prepare for Jesus we can also remember people who are part of our worldwide family. This year the children have been asked to collect for the Southwark Crisis Fund.
