Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

Gospel: Mark 1:29-39

Simon's mother-in-law is sick. She has a fever and is in bed. Jesus arrives at the house, takes her by the hand and helps her out of bed. Immediately she feels better. Later that day lots of people who were ill came to the place where Jesus was. Some of them may have travelled a long way. Jesus helps them all, curing them and making them feel better. What does this story tell us about Jesus? How does he heal the people that come to him? When was the last time that you were sick? How did you feel? Who helped you and made you feel better? What did they do to make you feel better? Sometimes when we are sick we have to see a doctor or go to the hospital. How long does it take to get from your house to the doctors? In some countries around the world people have to travel a very long way to see a doctor. This is very difficult, especially when they are ill. How do you think this makes them feel? How do you feel when you hear this? Jesus healed all those who came to him for help. Although we cannot heal people the way Jesus did, we can help them by making sure that wherever they are in the world, they are able to reach a doctor, or that the doctor can reach them, and that they get the medicine that they need. What one thing will you do to help someone who is sick this week?
