**Gospel:** Mark 1:40-45

Instead he asks the man to visit the priest and give thanks to God for his cure. How do you think this man felt when he realised that Jesus had healed him? Why do you think Jesus does not want the man to tell anyone about what he has done?

We try to be like Jesus today in our world. What are some ways that we can do that?
