Pentecost Sunday (Year B)

Gospel: John 20:19-23

The Gospel tells us about the Holy Spirit. The disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit and this gave them the courage to go out and tell everyone about Jesus. Let's think some more about the Holy Spirit. The disciples were scared of people they thought would hurt them and so they were hiding away. But when Jesus came they rejoiced, and he gave them a very special gift, the gift of the Holy Spirit. Suddenly the room that the disciples are sitting in is filled with the sound of a strong wind. Then the disciples are filled with the Holy Spirit. They go outside to tell people about Jesus and everyone can understand them – even people from far away who speak a different language! How do you think this happens?

Why do you think Jesus gave the Holy Spirit to the disciples? What difference do you think the Holy Spirit made to them? The Holy Spirit can be a difficult idea to understand. We can't see it, like we can see each other. The Holy Spirit is like the wind. We can't see the wind, but we can certainly feel it on a windy day. We can see the leaves moving in the trees because of the wind, or a kite flying high in a sky. The wind can be very strong and powerful. Can you think of any other ways that you can see the wind? Can you think of ways in which the wind is helpful? (eg windmills, sailing boats etc)

Just like the wind, we can see the effects of the Holy Spirit. Can you think of how we might see the effects of the Holy Spirit in our world? The Holy Spirit can work through us when we are kind to our family and friends, when we think about other people around the world, and when we work for people who are in need. Can you think of the last time you did any of these things?

The Holy Spirit can also give us courage to speak out, just like the disciples in the Bible readings. Can you think of a time when it might be difficult to say what you really think?

We can see that the world is not a very fair place. Many children around the world do not have enough food to eat or clean water to drink. What do you think you could do about that?
