The Most Holy Trinity (Year B)

Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20

In the Gospel reading we hear how Jesus sent out his disciples to spread his word. And Jesus tells us that he will always be with us. Let's think a bit more about this now.

Sometime after his death and resurrection Jesus appears to the disciples. He has a very special task for them. What does he ask them to do?

Jesus asks them to spread his word – to teach people to follow his commandments. Can you remember what these commandments are?

Jesus asks us to love God and to love our neighbour as ourselves. Can you think of a time when you have shown love for a neighbour? Jesus's words weren't just for his disciples – they were for all of us who follow him.

St Francis of Assisi said, "preach the gospel at all times, and when necessary use words." What do you think this means?

So what do you think the best way of sharing Jesus's word with other people is? Is it telling them about Jesus? Or do you think it might be better to show people through our actions?

What do you think we might do? We could be kind and generous and share with others. We could make sure that we always treat others the way we would want to be treated. We could try to make sure that the world is a fairer place for all people to live in. Can you think of anything else that we do to show we believe in Jesus?

At the end of the reading, Jesus says, "I am with you always, yes to the end of time."

How does it make you feel to know that Jesus is always with us? How do you know that Jesus is still with us today?

What will you do over the coming week to share Jesus's word with others through your actions?
