The Nativity of John the Baptist

Luke 1:57-66, 80

John the Baptist is a very important person in the Bible. Do you know who he is? Do you remember any other story about him? John's mother, Elizabeth, was not expected to have children, so when John was born it was a great gift to her and her husband Zechariah. Their friends and family were very pleased when the baby arrived. The first thing they wanted to know was his name. How did you get your name? Have you got a family story about where your name comes from?

John was an unusual name for his family but it was the name God had given him. It means 'God is gracious' and reminds us of God's kindness to us. Do you think it was a good name to give the baby? As John grew up, his faith in God showed that it was a very good choice.

Names are very important. Think about all the times that your name is used. In your school register, on your school bag, in clubs or competitions, in your passport. All these show that people know who you are.

This week, why not make a special effort to use people's names when you are speaking to them. Make it even more special by speaking to people you may not usually talk to.

And remember, God knows us all by name.
