Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

Gospel: Mark 10:13-16 (full reading Mark 10:2-16)

This week we are going to hear how special and important children were to Jesus. Let's think some more about how important all children are around the world. What do you remember from that reading? People were bringing their children to Jesus for his blessing but the disciples tried to stop them. Why do you think that the disciples did this? What did Jesus say to the disciples?

Jesus tells the disciples to let the children come to him and that the kingdom of God belongs to children like these. He says that children have a special way of looking at the world and understanding things, which adults can learn from. How does it make you feel to know that Jesus thinks all children are important and that he wanted to listen to them? Jesus welcomed and blessed the children that came to see him. He loves us all. No matter where in the world that we live.

With your help, charities are making a big difference to children's lives around the world.

Tomas from El Salvador has enough nourishing food to eat. Twalumba from Zimbabwe is growing up healthy and happy. David from Bolivia now has a wheelchair ramp in his classroom. Waed from Syria can go to school. Proscovia from Uganda has clean water.

In Sunday's gospel, Jesus protects the children and shows the disciples to care for them. We are also called to care for all children around the world because we are all brothers and sisters.
